Night Under The Stars raises money for The Passage – a charity that provides resources which encourage, inspire and challenge homeless people to transform their lives.

Night Under The Stars celebrates the awe-inspiring natural wonders of the Nordic lands.

Norwegian Edvard Grieg and Finn Jean Sibelius both took inspiration from landscape and myth, evoking in their music the mountains and fjords, forests and folk legends of their respective homelands. The concert features Grieg's ever-popular Piano Concerto (performed by Icelandic virtuoso Víkingur Ólafsson) and culminates in Sibelius' stirring tone poem *Finlandia* – considered to be Finland's alternative national anthem.

Themed receptions include Nordic-inspired food and drink under the Northern Lights, making for a magical evening in support of an inspiring cause.



Anyone can become homeless, given the wrong circumstances; redundancy, home repossession, a broken marriage, mental illness, violence or abuse.

The Passage believes in giving people a hand up, rather than a hand out. Established in 1980, we are located in the City of Westminster, which has the highest incidence of rough sleeping in the whole of London. We provide a broad range of frontline services that directly help people who are homeless and vulnerable, including London's largest voluntary Resource Centre, local street outreach work, short and longer-term accommodation facilities, access to health professionals and hands-on support with employment, education and training. We also run the 'Home for Good' project which recruits and matches volunteers to provide one to one support for former rough sleepers who are moving on to self-contained accommodation.
