We assist homeless people to realise their potential to transform their lives
1,544 people were helped off the streets;
98% of clients who used our Home for Good scheme maintained their accommodation



We act with compassion and kindness
35,194 visits were made to our Resource Centre to receive support and help



We are a voice for change and justice
We published *Understanding and Responding to Modern Slavery within the Homelessness Sector* to address the evil of modern slavery on our streets

95p in every £1 of voluntary income donated goes direct to frontline services

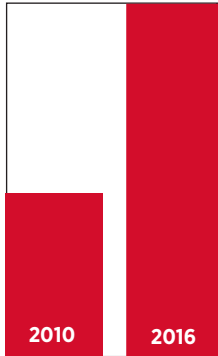


We build relationships based on trust

Each year The Passage must raise £2.7 million in voluntary income

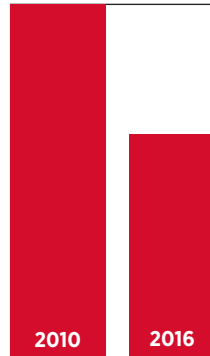
Rough sleeping

How your help makes a difference

£15 covers a food voucher for a week for someone who is starting a new job

£50 covers the cost of heating our Resource Centre for a whole week, keeping everyone who accesses the Centre warm!

£100 helps us pay a week's B&B accommodation for someone who we've supported into employment, but is waiting for secure housing to enable them to settle into their new job

£10,000 covers six months' support for our newly employed clients who need help with accommodation, travel and other expenses, to ensure that they can go to work happy, and maintain their employment
